Dear Colleagues

Some thoughts about the 4th Global Conference on Emergency Nursing and Trauma Care.

At the conference, it became clear how great the need for emergency care is globally. This requires good access to emergency care and increasingly skilled and knowledgeable nurses. This was also pointed out by Dr Emily McWhirter, a consultant at the WHO, who started the global campaign to train 25% of nurses and midwives in 25 countries in basic emergency care by the end of 2025.

Emergency departments are dynamic environments where nurses play a pivotal role in providing immediate and comprehensive care to diverse patients. To effectively navigate the complexities of ER settings, nurses must possess a multifaceted skill set, demonstrating competence in various areas and the ability to collaborate with different services, such as the police, social services, and more.

The conference presented, among other topics, the emergency care of various victims of violence, victims of trafficking, the care of migrants, and patients with mental problems. Emergency nurses have different roles and competencies when dealing with these groups. They must advocate for victims, ensuring their safety and well-being, providing culturally sensitive care, addressing language barriers, offering compassionate care and supporting these populations' unique needs. In doing so, they need cultural competence, language proficiency, forensic nursing skills, empathetic communication, psychiatric nursing skills, crisis intervention, knowledge of psychotropic medications, understanding of different policies, and more. They cooperate with various services such as social services, psychiatric services, police, and different support services. Nurses in emergency departments play a crucial role in providing patient-centred care to a wide array of individuals. The ability to adapt to the needs of different patient groups and collaborate with diverse services is essential. The conference clearly emphasized the need for continuous education and training to enhance nurses' competencies and ensure the delivery of high-quality care in the ever-evolving landscape of emergency healthcare.


